SUICIDE PREVENTION WEEK – LUNCH TIME LEARNING

Across the railway network the month of April experiences a higher number of suicide events than any other month during the year. In Wessex we are running a week long campaign to promote current initiatives and we are asking for everyone's help in preventing suicides by raising the awareness of these incidents and letting you know what you can do to help.

During this week of action we will be running two lunch time learning sessions in Basingstoke to raise awareness of suicide prevention and to promote the National Suicide Prevention Steering Group (NSPSG) learning tool. These are open to all staff to attend any of the sessions.

The briefings will provide you with a demonstration into how the new learning tool works; give you an opportunity to view some of the content and to learn what it offers you. There will also be an opportunity for you to ask questions to South West Trains staff as well as the BTP and the Samaritans at certain sessions in regards to Suicide prevention as well as the learning tool.
